INTRODUCTION

The Co-operative Public School is the second educational institution promoted and managed by the Thodupuzha Taluk Educational Co-operative Society Ltd. No. I-159.

The school is located at Mutharamkunnu, a hilltop resort, just on the outskirts of Thodupuzha Town, enjoying all the facilities of the town, but away from its din and dirt. The atmosphere is always calm, serene and well-suited for intellectual pursuit.

AIM

The School seeks to provide and maintain international standards in English education from LKG to Std. XII, under the CBSE Syllabus. Though Kerala has always fostered English education, the existing system has proved quite inadequate to cater to the needs of the present scenario. Often our career-seeking youth are elbowed out of the employment market, as they lack the adequate skill to communicate in English. The Co-operative Public School aims at providing quality English education to wipe out the drawbacks of the prevailing teaching system.

As a result of commercialisation, education has deteriorated to the level of 'Knowledge for work.' Instead of teaching the art of living, children are taught only how to make a living. It is imperative that growing minds should be trained in the art of living. We insist on value-based education which is a synchronisation of our goals and ends. The school offers a new mode of teaching which makes learning imaginative, innovative and inspiring. Special emphasis is also given to traditional and moral values in our curriculum.

The Co-operative Public School has evolved a holistic approach to education with a view to detect, develop and perfect the latent faculties of the students. Besides academic excellence, the institution aims at the overall development in extra-curricular activities, including sports, arts and games.

As we live in the global village of IT era, computer literacy and communicative skill in English have become the needs of the day. With a view to impart up-dated education and training, a computerised and well-equipped lab is also set up in the school.

ADMISSION

Admission to Kindergarten will be made after an interview with the Principal of the School. From Standard I onwards there will be a written test and interview.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

Two Mid Term Examinations and Two Terminal Examinations are conducted during the academic year. Promotion is based on the student's cumulative performance in all the examinations and internal assessments.

OPEN HOUSE

Parents are requested to be in constant touch with the teachers concerned, especially after each examination, for a regular feedback of their child's performance and progress. Marks will be intimated to the parents after each examination. Parents are expected to attend the Open House without fail.

ATTENDANCE

No pupil shall be promoted unless he/she has 80% of attendance during an academic year. Absence for a period of 15 days or more without submitting a leave note will result in the removal of the pupil's name from the rolls.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. Every leave record must be enlisted on the leave record page and signed by the parent or guardian.
2. Absence for more than three days should be informed to the Principal in writing.
3. Normally leave is not granted on examination days, and the first and last working days of the Term. Leave request for these days; if it is a must, should be made to the Principal in writing.
4. Leave application on medical ground should be supported by a medical certificate.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Exactness of uniform is applicable to all the students. No difference in the uniform will be permitted based on caste, creed or religion.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

1. Kindly read the diary for all instructions. Check the same on a daily basis and ensure that it is sent to school everyday. Train the child to complete his/her work in a systematic way on a daily basis.

3. Label all belongings of your child.

5. Kindly make sure that your child attends remedial/special classes if he/she is expected to do so.
6. Ensure that your child comes to school neatly groomed and dressed in the prescribed school uniform. Nails and hair should be kept trimmed and clean.
7. Make sure that your child is regular and punctual.
8. In case of contagious diseases send your child after complete recovery with a leave letter supported by a medical certificate.
9. Ensure that you make arrangements to collect your child from the bus stop.
10. Do not send money through your child unless requested for in writing from the school.
11. Your complaints / suggestions / appreciations should be intimated to the school in writing.
12. Your participation and support is solicited in all meetings, functions and workshops organized by the school in the interest of your child.

13. Avoid use of gold ornaments on your child to school. Fancy clips and fancy ear rings should be avoided.
14. Progress cards should be returned duly signed by the parent/guardian within a day or two.
15. Pupils will not be allowed to leave the school during the working hours. In case of emergency, the parent or the guardian should seek permission from the principal personally.
16. Parents are not allowed to go to the classes to meet their child or the teachers during class hours.
17. The school expects your whole-hearted co-operation and we request you to abide by the rules and regulations of the school.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS TO KG PARENTS

1. The books, pencil box, crayons will be kept at school.
2. Books will be sent home occasionally.
3. A handkerchief should be sent along with the child daily.
4. Intimation should be given to the office / teacher when sending money / medicine.
5. Avoid sending fish with bones.
6. Check your child's bag/diary daily.
7. Involve your child in a lot of creative activities at home (eg. Colouring, Doing paper work, Making them say stories etc.
8. Encourage your ward to talk about the activities at school.
9. Read out stories and sing songs to children as often as possible.

1. Proper and complete uniform is compulsory. A cheerful countenance and a dignified dressing and behaviour are always expected.
2. Be punctual and regular everyday and strive to put in full attendance.
3. Students are expected to communicate in good English inside the classrooms, school premises, buses and at bus stops.
4. Be polite, courteous and respectful to all, especially elders and members of the staff.
5. Mobile Phones, Jewellery, Fancy ornaments and Fancy Hair-clips are not permitted.
6. Note books, study materials and other records should be updated and maintained systematically.
7. Homework, projects or any other assignments allocated should be taken with due seriousness. Ensure timely completion and submission of the same.
8. Students should not destroy, damage or deface the institution's property. Violation of the same should be reported immediately to the concerned authority. The defaulter will be liable to make good the loss.
